- The Tribal College Dual Enrollment
 Program provides Arizona's high school students the opportunity to take college courses for both high school and college credit.
- Course costs are free to the student.
- Participating tribal colleges are reimbursed for tuition and fees associated with participating students.
- Effective September 24, 2022, the Arizona state legislature passed SB1300 allowing the Arizona Department of Education to reimburse the cost of books and instructional materials as well.



Why does this program exists?

General requirements for dual enrollment in Arizona are governed within the Arizona Revised Statute 15-1821.01.

In the 2015 Legislative session, the tribal college dual enrollment program was enacted. Thus, ARS Title 15, chapter 2, was amended by adding section 15-244.01 Tribal College Dual Enrollment Program Fund.

- Less questions- around 36 instead of 118
- Parents without SSN will be able to create a FSA ID in order to complete FAFSA
- Estimated Family Contribution will be changing to Student Aid Index
- Pell grant calculation changing
- Students can add up to 20 colleges
- The new FAFSA will be a role based form



With support and guidance from their families, school personnel and other advisors, students undergo a process of self-exploration, career exploration, and career planning & management.




My Future AZ supports the ECAP process

My Future AZ serves as a graduation and career planning tool for Arizona students. The tool empowers students to map out their career and education plan through a personalized platform.

Once a student is registered on the platform, students can invite their guardian(s) to create a parent account, which will then be linked to the student account, on the platform.

Career advisors can evaluate/manage students' progress in building their career and education plans throughout the student journey.






Connecting Interests to Career Pathways

Each career listing breaks down the career, education level, and percentage match strength to the student based on their assessment.






Dive into real Job, Education & Salary Data

Career pages also highlight open and projected jobs within the career, as well as the current companies that are hiring.










High School Course Planning

Based on what careers interest you, you can plan out what classes you need to take in high school to prepare you for that career.



Our **Course Planning page** allows you to see what needs to be a part of your plan for high school, to align directly with the career you would like to pursue.






ECAP Tasks

Opening the container will show all the tasks you should complete. You may also click **Education Career Action Plan** to be brought to an external resource.






Build Your Courses

From here you can **Save & Add Another** or **Save & Exit**. Once you're done, you can export as a PDF for your records.






Student Profile






Resources

These can be uploaded by your **School Admin** for the students at your school to utilize.






Invite Parent/Guardian
